Roundup: A.L. takes two in Treynor

TREYNOR – Abraham Lincoln earned two big wins at the Treynor Softball Classic Saturday, knocking off Logan-Magnolia 9-0 before taking down Glenwood 11-9 in a time-limited, five-inning contest.

The Lynx amassed 20 hits between the two games, and that offensive output made coach Pat Kroll pleased.

“They hit the ball well today,” Kroll said. “It wasn’t too bad at all. Offensively, I was very happy. We’re starting to come along.”

Kristin Burhenne, Lauren Meeker and MacKenzie Bolton each had at least two RBIs in the Lynx’s victory over Logan-Magnolia.

Michaela Kennedy tossed a shutout in the circle in her first game back after missing time with shoulder tendonitis.

A.L. didn’t miss a beat offensively against Glenwood. Meeker again enjoyed a fine performance at the plate, finishing with a home run, a double and four RBIs. Chelsea Acosta added three hits and Morgan Hively had three RBIs.

The Lynx will travel to Tri-Center for a nonconference contest Tuesday.

In other action Saturday, Glenwood bounced back from its loss to A.L. with a 5-1 triumph over Class 1-A No. 10 Treynor. The Rams scored four first-inning runs and hung on for the victory.

Treynor won a 13-4 decision over Logan-Magnolia earlier in the day. Kaitlin Floerchinger earned the win for the Cardinals in the circle, and Nichole Easton hit a three-run triple.
