SWI Roundup: A.L. softball team loses two one-run games

LOGAN – Abraham Lincoln came up one run short in both games it played at the Panther Tournament on Saturday, losing 3-2 to Maple Valley-Anthon-Oto and 2-1 to Logan-Magnolia in eight innings.

In the first game, A.L. had five hits against MV-A-O, but only managed two runs, both in the bottom of the seventh inning. Lauren Meeker plated Lauren Rommel and Taylor Powers on her single.

Pitcher Michaela Kennedy struck out seven, but also walked seven in the loss.

The Lynx battled the host school, Lo-Ma, in their next game. It went an extra inning, with the Panthers coming out on top. A.L. had eight hits in the contest, but could only get one run across.

Lo-Ma held a 1-0 lead for most of the game until the bottom of the seventh inning, when Lauren Meeker connected on a single that scored Taylor Anderson.

Lo-Ma scored the winning run in the top of the eighth.

Kennedy allowed only two hits in the game, but came away with the loss. The Lynx will play at St. Albert on Monday.

“We waited too late to get going,” said Abraham Lincoln assistant coach Al Leaders.
